Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship Program
Hosted by Shanghai International Studies University (SISU)

Brief Introduction:

Shanghai Summer School, abbreviated as 3S, is a scholarship program provided by Shanghai Municipal Government, aiming to encourage more foreign young people to come to China, to learn Chinese language and to experience Chinese culture. Entrusted by Shanghai Municipal Education Commission, Shanghai International Studies University (SISU) has hosted successfully since 2015 one of the 3S programs which recruits outstanding students from **“One Belt, One Road” Countries**.

Duration:

From July 11 to August 5, 2016 (4weeks)

Place:

Hongkou Campus of SISU

Study Plan & Extracurricular Activities:

- Chinese courses (including grammar, conversation, listening comprehension, etc.), 18-20 teaching hours per week, 4 teaching hours each morning (8:30-11:50), Monday through Friday.
- Additional courses of Chinese Culture Practice, such as Chinese Traditional Calligraphy, Artistic Paper Cutting, Taijiquan (shadow boxing).
- Inner city visits.
- Cultural experience.

Items Covered by the Scholarship:

- Application fee & Tuition
- Teaching Materials
- Visits and Cultural experience organized by SISU
- Accommodation (double room at SISU's International Students' Residence).
- ★ The other expenses will be borne by the applicants themselves, such as flight ticket, visa, etc..

Admission Qualifications:

Senior high school graduates, with or without Chinese proficiency, over 18 and under 40 years old, in good health, and with reliable financial support and custody.

Application deadline:

May 15, 2016.
